Re: Compliance with California Prop 65 Requirements – Apparel Products

Dear Customer,

Please allow this to update you on Fruit of the Loom's compliance with the current requirements of California Health and Safety Code section 25249.5, more commonly known as "Proposition 65." Please note that all of the products sold to you by Fruit of the Loom are part of our regular testing program. We test our products for compliance with the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act, and other applicable industry and legal standards, and we screen our raw materials and supply chain to identify potential Proposition 65 substances. We are comfortable that our products meet or exceed all current requirements. Further, we have no reason to believe that any of the apparel products or styles sold to you by Fruit of the Loom contain any Proposition 65 substances which would result in an impermissible exposure level. Please be advised that this certification is for the finished products that we sell to you. If a blank product we sell is later decorated by a third party, our testing and certifications will not apply to the decoration.

Should we become aware of any contrary information, we will notify you and address the situation in accordance with the requirements of Proposition 65.

We will defend, indemnify and hold you and your employees, officers and directors harmless from and against any and all fines, costs, expenses, penalties, and damages ("Claims") arising out of or relating to our breach of the foregoing; provided, however, that you (a) promptly give us written notice of the Claim; (b) give us sole control of the defense and settlement of the Claim; and (c) assist us, upon our reasonable request, with the defense of the Claim.
